



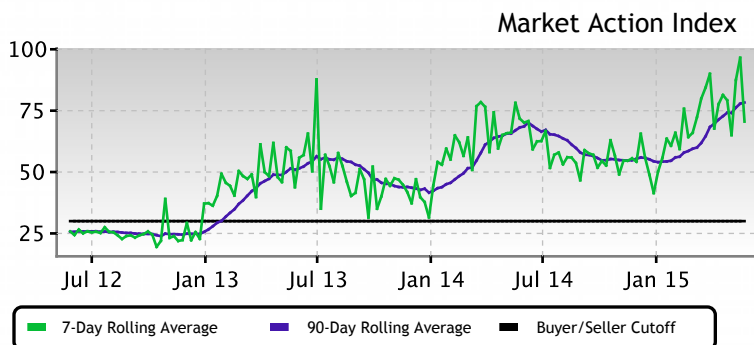
This Week

The median list price in AURORA, CO this week is \$425,000.

The Market Action index has been trending down lately, while days-on-market is climbing, providing mostly bearish signs for the market.

Supply and Demand

- Home sales continue to outstrip supply and the Market Action Index has been moving higher for several weeks. This is a Seller's market so watch for upward pricing pressure in the near future if the trend continues.



The Market Action Index answers the question "How's the Market?" by measuring the current rate of sale versus the amount of the inventory. Index above 30 implies Seller's Market conditions. Below 30, conditions favor the buyer.
